 (i) Whether found actually copying from a printed book or manuscript noted relating to the subject of the Examination of that day.

Those are only tentative questions if necessary, detailed report by the concerned invigilator may be given sepa-

- (ii) Whether found in possession of papers or printed matter relating to the Examination either in his pocket or under the table, and found actually copying from it.
- (iii) Whether found copying outside the Examination Hall in corridors of bath-rooms.
- (iv) Whether found talking to another candidate, if so, the name of the other candidate may also be given.
- (v) Whether found in communication with persons outside the Examination Hall trying to substitute another answer book from outside, if so, please give particulars, if possible of such persons outside.
- (vi) The exact time at which the Chief Superintendent or Invigilator discovered the candidate guilty malpractice.

The report should be filed up by the invigilator and countersigned by the Chief Superintendent with his own remarks and opinion on the case. This report should also be accompanied, whether possible, by a statement made by the candidate himself/ herself in writing and of all papers seized from him / her. The answerbooks of candidates resorting to malpractice should be forwarded to the Controller of Examinations along with this report. The seating plan of the Examination Hall where the candidate was bought resorting to malpractice must be sent along with this.
